

Camp Trinity

Camp Trinity is the co-ed residential summer camp sponsored by the Episcopal Diocese of East Carolina and operated by Trinity Center. Camp Trinity offers a variety of traditional camping activities (swimming, sailing, sports, campfire) in an intentionally Christ-centered community. The camping program serves over 600 children of the diocese during its ten weeks of operation each year. Eighty children attend camp each week, and they are supervised by a staff of twenty committed college age individuals, most former campers themselves. In addition, a different clergyperson of the diocese serves as session leader each week, providing spiritual direction and Christian programming.

Camp Trinity is open to all children, with equal preference given to members of parishes in the Diocese of East Carolina and returning campers until March 1 of each year. Applications are mailed to individuals and parishes in mid-January each year. Camp Trinity does have financial assistance available for children who might otherwise be unable to attend.
