Make an offering for each Blessing-UTO Blue Boxes have allowed us to do this for years.

Once all the thank offerings are collected, the UTO Board gives them away as grants. UTO grants often focus on urgent human needs – meaning your individual gratitude gift helps with racial reconciliation efforts, ending poverty, and much more.

The thank offerings that you put into your Blue Box combined with others, funds innovative missions and ministry in The Episcopal Church and the Anglican Communion. UTO Grants can be used for startup funds for new ministries or take a current ministry in a new and exciting direction. This year Father Fred is applying for a UTO grant for the Hispanic ministry.
