

**SPECIAL ORDER OF BUSINESS
FOR
THE 139TH ANNUAL CONVENTION**

The 139th Annual Convention of the Diocese of East Carolina adopts the following Special Order for the conduct of the Convention meeting June 3-4, 2022, having been rescheduled from February 11-12, 2022 due to the declared State of Emergency and Executive Orders of the Governor of the State of North Carolina in response to the coronavirus pandemic.

1. The following sections of the Canons regarding the conduct of the Convention are suspended for the Annual Convention in 2022:

- (a) Title I, Canon 1, section 4 (c), regarding the Resolutions Committee.
- (b) Title I, Canon 1, section 4 (e), regarding the Elections Committee.

The Resolutions Committee and Elections Committee will be those appointed by the Bishop for the 139th Annual Convention.

2. Rule VIII of the Rules of Order for the conduct of the Convention is suspended for the 139th Annual Convention in 2022 and the following Rule will apply in its stead:

VIII. Speakers shall address the chair, and shall confine themselves to the point in debate.

- (1) No motion shall be considered unless seconded, and if the motion is to amend the motion or resolution under debate, reduced to writing.
- (2) All resolutions received by 10:00 am on June 4 will be considered by Convention.

3. These Special Rules of Order apply only to the meeting of the 139th Annual Convention in 2022 and expire upon its adjournment.
